Church World Service, the organizer of CROP Walks, assists communities in overcoming systemic local hunger and provides disaster relief, along with promoting fair national and international policies. Through CROP Walks, CWS raises millions from generous donors and participants like you. These gifts transform whole communities, for example, through building sand dams to harvest rain water for long-term storage for communities that otherwise do not have adequate water resources.

We have a set a goal of raising \$5000 this year, 25% of which will support the Blessing Bench Food Pantry in Joliet, a ministry that feeds nearly 400 people every week. The other 75% of our goal could cover half the cost for CWS to build a sand damn to provide long-term water resources for a rural community in Africa that can last as long as 50 years!

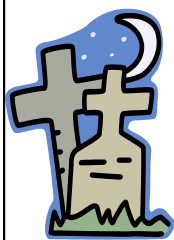
