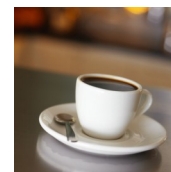

### Joplin Mission Trip Meeting

Following the making of the pizzas we will convene a meeting about the mission trip in June for all interested parties at 1:00pm.

### Mission Trip to Joplin - June 17-23

This year PUMC youth are traveling to Joplin, MO, to work through the Missouri Annual Conference of the United Methodist Church to serve Joplin's

long-term recovery efforts after the utterly devastating tornado that struck Sunday afternoon, May 22, 2011.

We open up this trip to youth within PUMC, their extended family, and their friends. Eligible youth are those entering 7<sup>th</sup> grade in 2012 through high school seniors graduating this spring. The costs for this trip are relatively low thanks to the efforts of the United Methodist Church. Each youth will pay a \$50 commitment contribution, which will go to a fund administered by the UMC to help people replace what they lost in the tornado. The MO Conference requests a \$100 contribution to the same fund for each adult leader.

God may be calling you to serve in one or two ways to make this mission trip successful:

- You may be called to be an adult leader for the trip. You need have no special skills. You need only to devote yourself for one week to serve alongside the youth as a team to serve those recovering from the horrible disaster.
- You may be called to be a generous financial donor to support the trip. Adult leaders give of their precious time to serve and need not also give financially. Perhaps you are called to support the service of an adult leader by donating the \$100 mentioned above? Pray about it, and when the time comes God will call you to help in whatever way you can.

Beyond the \$50 and \$100 mentioned above, the costs for rental vans, gas, food, and donation to host church for the week will be about \$250 per person. We are on our way to

paying for these costs, and we will cover them 100% through fundraisers and a fundraising letter that youth will send to likely supporters.

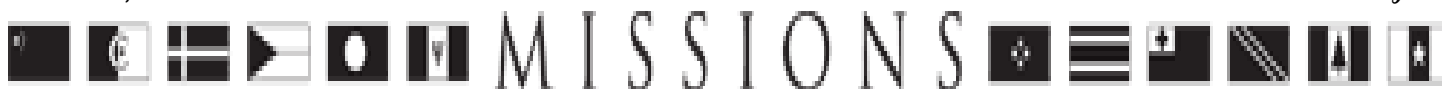
### Scrip Cards Inventory

Thanks to your participation in buying Scrip cards, PUMC youth have raised more than \$1000 since July 2011. Those proceeds currently exist, however, in Scrip cards inventory. To realize these proceeds into cash we need to sell all of the cards in inventory.

Please visit the Scrip table in Friendship Hall Sunday mornings to help unload the inventory.

The cost of shipping diminishes our returns and requires substantial effort to manage the process. Starting this month we invite you to place your Scrip **orders once a month**, which will be placed the Monday following the 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday for pick-up the following Sunday.

As always, if you register at ShopWithScrip.com and link your checking account through PrestoPay, you can reload cards and buy ScripNow! vouchers delivered instantly through email. & proceeds deposit directly into the PUMC youth account. For example, you're going to Chili's with your family for a fun dinner out. You go to ShopWithScrip.com, order \$25 in Chili's ScripNow!, get the voucher from your email, and **11%** goes directly to the PUMC youth account. The whole transaction takes a minute. Kathy Wellman, who has been very involved in our church programs since joining in 1998, has felt the call to begin the process of becoming a Methodist minister. Kathy and Eric, her husband, have two children, Elizabeth and Claire.

Kathy graduated with a degree in Special Education from Illinois State in 1996, and received a Master's Degree in Educational Leadership in 2004 from Aurora University. In 2009, during a Disciple 1 course in our church, she felt the stirrings of a call to ministry. After working with our Minister of Faith Formation, she felt the call solidify.

Our Staff-Parish Relations Committee interviewed Kathy in May, 2011 and voted unanimously to recommend and support her as a candidate for ministry. In October, she was officially presented to our District Superintendent as a candidate for ordained ministry. She took one course, "An Introduction to the Old Testament" at Garrett Theological Seminary first semester, and plans to take "An Introduction to Theology" second semester.

Our Missions Committee has voted to help her with some of her traveling expenses to and from school this first year, with the expectation of increasing financial help as she progresses.
