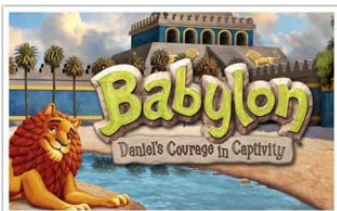


Vacation Bible School 2012!
