CPR TRAINING OFFERED
 The American Heart Association's Heartsaver CPR/AED Class is scheduled from 5-9pm on **Tuesday, June 26th** in JBFH. The class teaches

the skills of Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation and use of the Automatic External Defibrillator in the emergency of cardiac arrest. Physically, this requires the ability to get down on your knees and "push hard and fast" to give compressions. The emergencies of choking, heart attack and stroke are also addressed. Please consider attending this important class. The knowledge you gain will enable you to respond in an emergency situation and perhaps save a life. Several people who took the class in 2010 are now in need of recertification. Cost of the class is \$15 and books are available for \$15. I will schedule another class if needed as class size is limited to 10 people. Thank you for your consideration of this important training.
