At the 8:30am worship service child care is provided in the Nursery in Room 208 for Infants thru Preschoolers, and at 9:30 am for Infants through Toddlers

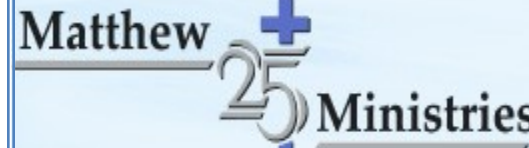
COFFEE HOUR IN THE FELLOWSHIP HALL

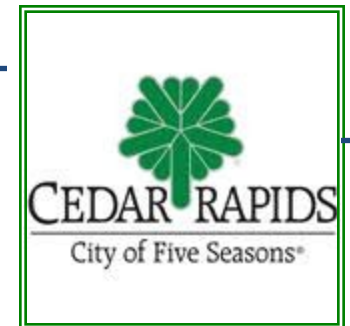
