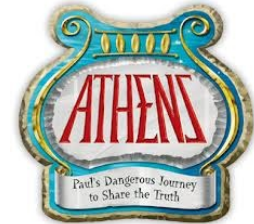

For June: We will be reading *The Great Gatsby* by F. Scott Fitzgerald and seeing the movie on the big screen on Thursday, June 20th (time TBA).

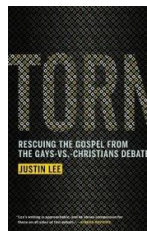
