## YOUTH MISSION TRIP to Russellville, KY

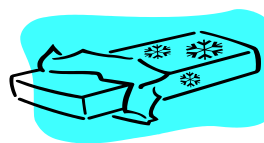
Early this morning our youth and adults left on the Mission Trip. Please pray for them as they go forth and serve. They will return Saturday, June 22.
