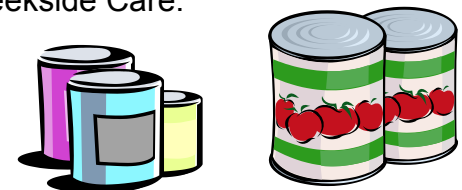
CREEKSIDE CARES SUMMER STOCK UP:

POSTER FOR VBS SNACK LIST

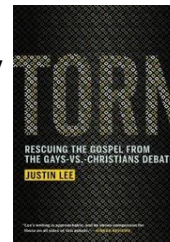
