## Book and a Movie

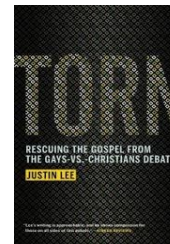


The Women's book group continues this summer's "Book and a Movie" series! Come join us!
