### THIS WEEK'S PROJECT—

**LEE MEMORIAL GIRLS' MISSION** - This is a United Methodist - sponsored mission in Calcutta, India. The children who come to the mission are in hopeless situations: Some are newborns, and have been left somewhere, found and brought to the center. Others are orphans, or from a family who cannot afford to care for another child.

The mission provides nurturing care, religious and secular education for the girls until they reach the age of 18, or are able to support themselves.

It was established in the early 1900's by a Methodist missionary couple whose children were killed in an avalanche.

Lee Memorial Girls' Mission is our International project on our Rainbow Covenant List.

All funds raised will be used for projects on our Rainbow Covenant List.

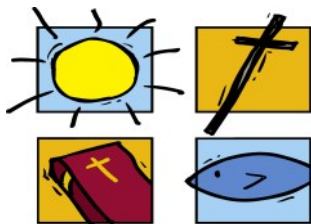
## Book and a Movie
