almost nothing. They need clothes, shoes, and other items.

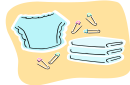


The girls are ages 2, 4, 5, and 10 - shoe sizes 6, 9, and 11.

**All funds raised will be used for projects on our Rainbow Covenant List.**

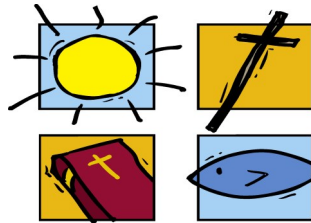
## Book and a Movie
