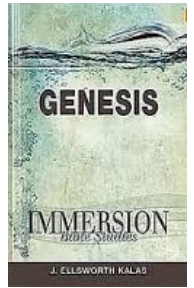
Annual School Supply Drive August 18th - September 8th.
