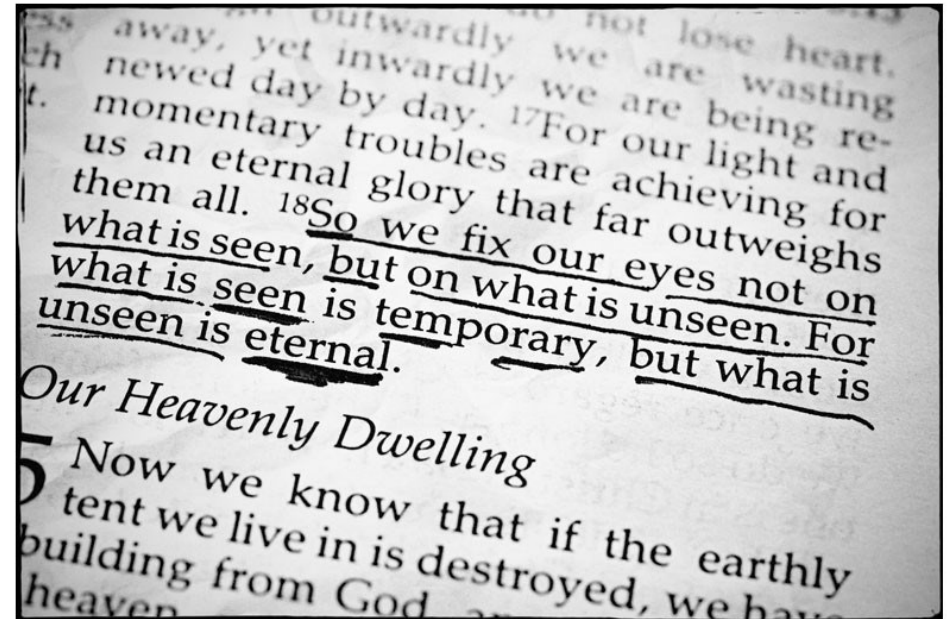
**CHILD CARE**
