Last year when I began serving as Chair of the Finance Committee, I personally was filled with dread. Just did not know how the Finance Committee was going to get through the year with all our obligations. Many of you may remember my presentation to the congregation last spring where I demonstrated how we were short of funds to support all ministries of our church, including apportionments. You were all to pray for an answer.

Our prayers are getting answered! Last year our giving was 4% over what we anticipated. We also received funds from the YMCA to cover their building usage. We ended the last year by paying 40% of our apportionments. Fortunately, Missions was able to contribute towards that as well thanks to the awesome funds generated by the Pie Auction! Still short by almost \$40,000 of what we were supposed to pay, we still paid more than we thought we could. One of the additional concerns has been that our building remodel is getting older. Repairs are going to need to be made. While there is money in the budget for the regular day to day maintenance, we had nothing set aside for an emergency. We were able to designate an additional \$15,000 towards this Emergency Fund.

Last fall, our Stewardship Committee worked very hard on the process of Consecration Sunday. On that day many people committed more in pledges than the year before. Some people who had never pledged, committed to do so. The pledge cards kept coming in for the next several weeks. By the end of the year, the pledges totaled \$414,200. This was 15% over the previous year! We have made huge progress! Your generous giving makes the ministries of our church possible.

Thanks to all of you who prayed. Thanks to all of you who decided to take the plunge and make the commitment to pledge. Thank you to all of you who increased your giving. Keep up the great work. Honor your commitments. And keep praying!

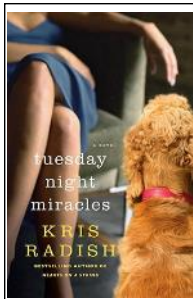

2015 ADULT MISSION TRIP AUGUST 2-8, 2015



We are heading back to work with our incredible partners at Bahamas Methodist Habitat! This time, all adults in the 20's, 30's, and 40's are invited to join the team!

The specific mission site will likely be some type of construction/building project with opportunities to interact with local folks. The trip as a whole will cost approximately \$1500/person (with some wiggle room for airfare). This includes travel expenses, lodging, meals, and building supplies for the project. Young adults (up through age 35) are eligible for a special scholarship to fund their trip expenses. Scholarship applications must be received no later than April 15, 2015. There are a limited number of spots available for this trip. **To secure your spot, you must send in a non-refundable \$250 deposit to Plainfield United Methodist Church ("Bahamas" in the memo line) no later than April 15th, 2015.**

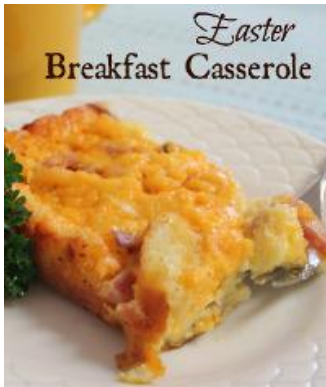


Sunday School Staff Appreciation Day
