Vacation Bible School 2017!



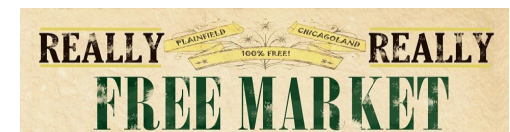
July 9-13, 6:30-8:30 pm

There will be no 8:30 worship on June 11.

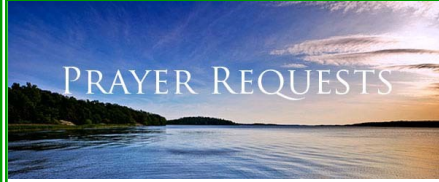
PUMC to Begin Reconciling Discernment Process. The United Methodist Church, as a denomination, has long struggled over the inclusion or exclusion of gay, lesbian, bisexual, and transgender people. Many changes have been made to the Book of Discipline and conversations are ongoing.

In February, PUMC's leadership council unanimously voted to open up a time of conversation and study on whether or not to become a Reconciling Congregation - a faith community that explicitly welcomes all people, including our LGBTQ siblings in faith.

As a congregation, we can learn and grow through our discernment process. It will be important to remember that no matter the final decision, **which will be made by the congregation as a whole**, we can seek to be ever more loving and faithful to Jesus Christ.

Over the summer we will begin a series of "fireside chats" beginning on June 21, 7:00p.
