Summer Sunday School begins June 3 during 9:30am worship!



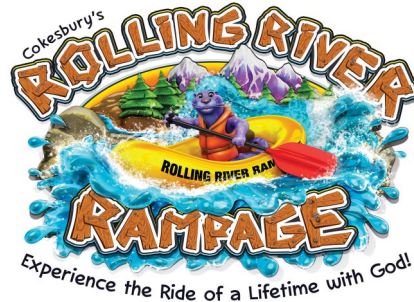

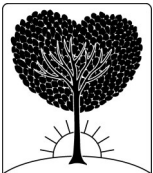
