



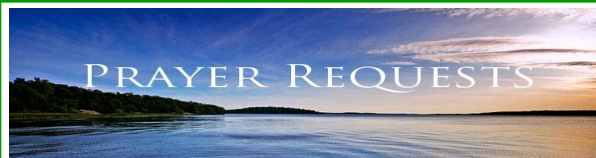

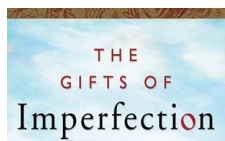


**BEWARE!!!**

Come have fun with us! Pick up the book, read it, and then come to book club to discuss the book. We have games, art projects, and amazing snacks.

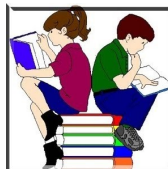

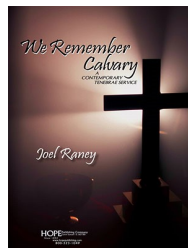
