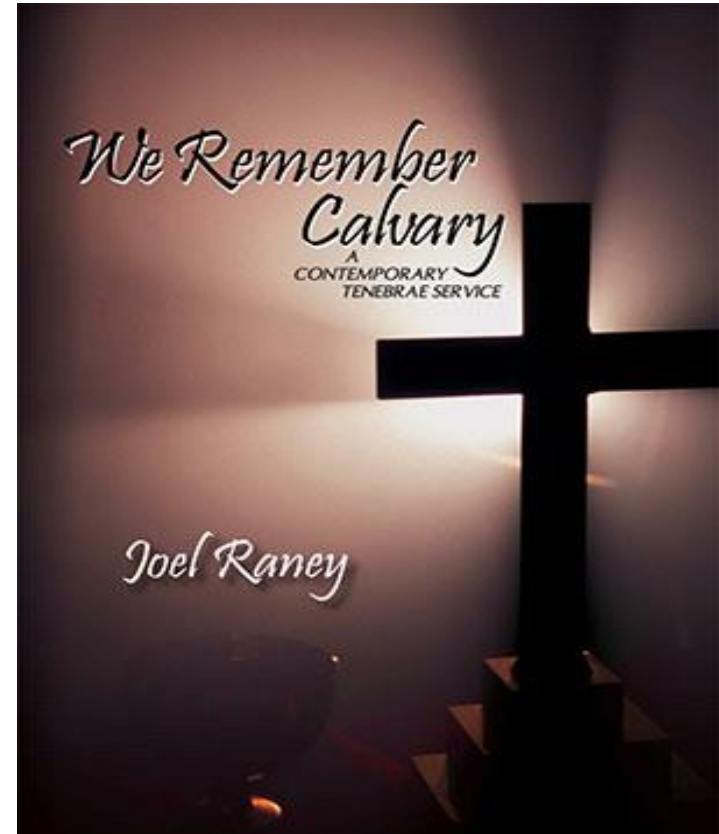
CHILDCARE
