**12:00pm - Good Friday** Community Worship Service at St. Mary's Immaculate Church

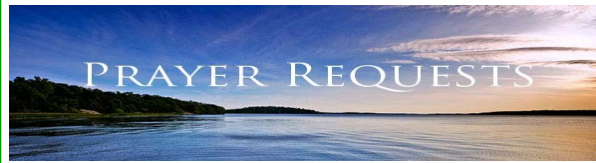
