12:00pm - Good Friday Community Worship Service at St. Mary's Immaculate Church

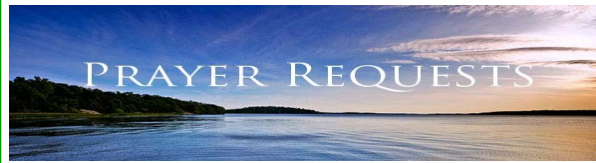
