Ascribe to the Lord the glory due his name; bring an offering and come before him. Worship the Lord in the splendor of his holiness." (1 Chronicles 16:29)

Our annual giving supports our church's ministry and mission. There are three important reasons why we return annual commitment cards.

WORSHIP – We believe returning a portion of our financial resources to God's work through our church is an act of worship. We are thankful for our blessings and acknowledge that all we have is a gift from God. As an expression of worship, we symbolically return the first fruits of our labor as an offering to the Lord.

STEWARDSHIP – One of our membership expectations is to give in proportion to our income. We are not told how much to give; that is a personal decision. The Biblical standard introduced by Abraham was the tithe, the giving of the first 10% of one's income to God. For many, the tithe is just the beginning. If you are currently not tithing, our hope is you will commit a percentage of your income and increase that amount as you are able in the future to reach the tithe.

MINISTRY – Annual commitments make it possible for our church to budget and plan for the coming year. Worship, programs for children and teens, adult Bible studies and small groups, pastoral care and support, mission trips and community projects are all supported by the annual giving that provides the operating funds for our church.

Over the years, we have committed our resources to God, and God has blessed and used them to change lives, transform communities and renew the church.

WORSHIP WITH GRATITUDE

On Commitment Sunday, November 19, we present our commitments to God during worship. This is an opportunity as a congregation to express our gratitude to God and renew our commitment to being God's stewards in the world.

STEP 1

If you are not regularly giving to your church, make a commitment to giving at least \$5 per week (\$20 per month) and return a 2024 Annual Commitment Card.

STEP 2

Commit to increasing your giving for 2024 by 1% to 3% of your income, as you move toward the goal of giving the tithe, 10% of your income, and return a 2024 Annual Commitment Card.
