Plainfield United Methodist Church is proud to offer a great scholarship opportunity for the continuing education of graduating high school students, the *Doris Stabler Scholarship*, for PUMC members and active participants.

Doris Stabler was an active member of PUMC. Her love of children and desire to promote continuing education led her to provide an endowment that would offer scholarships to PUMC students of good moral character and academic standing.

This year students meeting the criteria will be given an opportunity to earn up to \$3,000 for 2025-2026 tuition or educational expenses to any accredited, post-secondary educational institution. This may be applied to college, junior college, trade school, apprenticeship, etc.

Applications and information as described on the reverse side should be received in a sealed envelope addressed to Plainfield UMC, c/o Doris Stabler Scholarship Youth Advisory Ministry Panel (by mail or delivery in person) <u>in the church office no later than Sunday, March 30, 2025</u>. Recipients will be chosen based on the application's criteria and notified on/before Wednesday, April 16th.

Applicants must be active participants or active members of PUMC. Applications will be reviewed by YMAP, which will determine scholarship awards. This scholarship may be renewed for \$1,000 per year for the next three years. A renewal application will be made available in January of 2026.

On behalf of Plainfield United Methodist Church, and the Doris Stabler Scholarship, we encourage our graduating PUMC seniors to take advantage of this opportunity, and we wish each of you success in your continuing education and your faith journey.

A **personal statement of at least 500 words** (that is, at least one full-page, typed, single-spaced, 12-point font, one-inch margins), which includes information regarding:

- What "good moral character" means to you and how you have demonstrated this through volunteer work, good citizenship, and/or extra-curricular activities
- Your future goals
- Your involvement and spiritual journey as a member of PUMC

A **copy of the letter of acceptance** or other evidence of enrollment in the accredited, post-secondary educational institution you named above (university, college, junior college, trade school, apprenticeship, etc.)

*Scholarship funds will be paid directly to you by the end of February 2026. Please submit your first semester transcript or your second semester class schedule to the church office, as soon as you receive them. You bear all responsibility for applying the money to eligible expenses, such as tuition and course-related expenses (fees, books, supplies, and equipment required for courses.
